We use cookies to provide you with the service and obtain statistics on the use of the website.

1.- What is a cookie and what is it for?

A cookie is a text file that is sent to the web browser of your computer, mobile or tablet and that serves to store and retrieve information about the navigation carried out. For example, remembering your username and password or your profile preferences.

2.- What types of cookies are there?

According to who manages them:

- Own cookies: are sent to your browser from our computers or web domains.
- Third-party cookies: are sent to your browser from a computer or web domain that we do not manage directly, but a third party entity such as Google.

Depending on how long they are active, there are:

- Session cookies: they remain in the cookie file of your browser until you leave the website, so that none remain on your device.
- Persistent cookies: they remain on your device and our website reads them every time you make a new visit. These cookies stop working after a specific date.

Finally, and according to its purpose, we have:

- Technical and functional cookies: are those that allow the user to navigate through a web page, platform or application and the use of the different options or services that exist in it.
- Analytical cookies: are those that allow the person responsible for them to monitor and analyze the behavior of users of the websites to which they are linked. The information collected through this type of cookies is used to measure the activity of the websites, application or platform and to prepare navigation profiles of the users of said sites, applications and platforms, in order to introduce improvements based on the analysis of the usage data made by the users of the service.
- Advertising cookies: are those that allow the management, in the most efficient way possible, of the advertising spaces that, where appropriate, the publisher has included in a web page, application or platform from which it provides the requested service based on criteria such as edited content or how often ads are shown.
- Behavioral advertising cookies: they collect information about the user's preferences and personal choices (retargeting) to allow the management, in the most efficient way possible, of the advertising spaces that, where

appropriate, the publisher has included in a web page, application or platform from which it provides the requested service.

- Social cookies: they are set by the social media platforms on the services to allow you to share content with your friends and networks. Social media platforms have the ability to track your online activity outside of the Services. This may affect the content and messages you see on other services you visit.
- Affiliate cookies: they allow you to track visits from other websites, with which the website establishes an affiliation contract (affiliate companies).
- Security cookies: they store encrypted information to prevent the data stored in them from being vulnerable to malicious attacks from third parties.
